Urjit Patel, a former Governor of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), has been appointed as Vice President of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) for a three-year term.

He will be one of the AIIB's five Vice Presidents. From February 2022, he is likely to assume command.

He will take over for outgoing Vice President D J Pandian, who is responsible for the AIIB's sovereign and non-sovereign lending in South Asia, the Pacific Islands, and Southeast Asia.

All of Queen Elizabeth II's and Prince Philip's military and regal titles have been taken away from Prince Andrew, Duke of York, the third child and second son of the Queen and Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh.

After being implicated in a sexual assault controversy, the Royal family member, who was ninth in line of succession to the British monarch, was obliged to surrender all ties with royal titles.

He will no longer be a member of the military or have royal patronage.

Quick Fact: The titles and patronages of Prince Andrew have been returned to his mother, Queen Elizabeth II.

Subhas Sarkar, Minister of State, has launched the Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar.

Subhas Sarkar, Minister of State for Education, has virtually launched the Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar (SVP) 2021–2022. The Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar honours, motivates, and rewards schools that have excelled in the areas of water, sanitation, and hygiene, while also serving as a benchmark and road map for schools to develop in the future. The Department of School Education and Literacy first distributed the Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar in 2016-17 to encourage self-motivation and raise cleanliness awareness.

Roberta Metsola is the new president of the European Parliament.

Roberta Metsola, a Maltese Christian Democrat, has been chosen president of the European Union's parliament. Her victory comes just a week after the unexpected death of outgoing parliament president David Sassoli, who was set to stand down as part of a power-sharing agreement. She is the first woman to be elected to the position. She is the youngest president of the European Parliament. Metsola received 458 of the 616 votes cast as the nominee of the parliament's largest faction.

Quick Fact: The European Union's parliament has its headquarters in Strasbourg, France.

The Asian Cup for Women's Football will be held in India in 2022.

From January 20th to January 20th, 2022, India will host the AFC Women's Football Asian Cup India 2022 in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, and Pune. Twelve teams will compete for the trophy in this competition. The AFC Women's Asian Cup in India will also serve as the final stage of Asian qualification for the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023, which will be held in Australia and New Zealand. The first black woman to be featured on a US coin is Maya Angelou, a poet.

The US Treasury has produced coins honouring poet Maya Angelou, the first black woman to appear on a quarter in the United States. Poet and activist Maya Angelou was the first black woman to write and perform a poem during a presidential inauguration.



The "heads" side of the new coin still depicts George Washington, while the "tails" side pays tribute to Angelou by invoking one of her most famous writings, the autobiography "I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings."

Quick Fact: She has been awarded by the President Barack Obama for the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest civilian honour in the United States, in 2010.

The Government of India has issued a stamp to commemorate one year of Covid immunisation.

On the first anniversary of the country's national immunisation programme against the virus, India's government produced a commemorative postage stamp on the Covid-19 vaccination on January 16, 2022.

Under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Textiles, the AEPC is India's official body of clothing exporters, providing crucial help to both Indian exporters and importers/international buyers.

This championship was supposed to take place in 2020-21, but it was postponed first to 2022, then to 2023 owing to a coronavirus outbreak.



The tournament is projected to attract a minimum of eight countries, and it will be the first time that such an international event is hosted in India with ICSD approval."

Shaylyn Ford, who represented the United States in the pageant, defeated 57 other women from around the world to win the title.

This was the 8th time the title Mrs. World has been won by an American representative.

The Arrow-3 was successfully tested in flight by Israel.

The Arrow-3, which is meant to intercept ballistic missiles beyond the earth's atmosphere, has successfully completed a flight test in Israel.

Israel Aerospace Industries led the test, which was conducted at a test location in central Israel (IAI).

The Missile Defense Organization of the Defense Ministry and the American Missile Defense Agency collaborated on the project.

After months of delays and technical difficulties, the Arrow 3 was successfully tested in February 2018.

Quick Fact: The Arrow-3 has been in development since **2008** and is thought to be one of the most powerful weapons of its kind in the world.

Special Repo Auction by the RBI

Instead of utilising variable rate reverse repo operations (VRRR) to suck out funds, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) performed a variable rate repo operation on January 20, 2022 to infuse liquidity.

Larger goods and services tax (GST) collections recently restricted liquidity, necessitating this action.

The Reserve Bank of India has suggested lending the banking system Rs 50,000 crore in a single day, after receiving bids for Rs 65,700 crore.

Quick Fact: There is a Rs 6 trillion surplus in total system liquidity due to this. This money is sufficient to keep money market rates low.

India Tennis Star Sania Mirza To Retire After 2022 Season

Sania Mirza, India's most successful female tennis player, will retire at the end of the 2022 season.

In 2013, the 35-year-old had already withdrawn from singles events. On September 26, 2021, she won the Ostrava Open in women's doubles with Chinese partner Shuai Zhang, earning national attention.

Ramanujacharya was a revolutionary social reformer who lived in the 11th century. It is housed in a 45-acre campus in Shamshabad, Telangana, on the outskirts of Hyderabad.

To drive digital transactions in rural and semi-urban areas, the Reserve Bank of India has developed a framework for allowing small-value digital payments in offline mode utilising cards, wallets, mobile devices, and other methods.

Authorised Payment System Operators (PSOs) and Payment System Participants (PSPs), Acquirers and Issuers (banks and non-banks) will be allowed to undertake small value offline digital payments using the framework.

Quick Fact: An offline payment transaction's top limit was set at ₹200, with a total limit of ₹2,000 at any given moment.

Mia Mottley, the Prime Minister of Barbados, gets re-elected for a second term.

He is India's first Olympic gold medalist in the sport of track and field. In the Indian army, Neeraj is a Subedar.

In 2016, he enlisted as a straight entry Naib Subedar in the 4 Rajputana Rifles. He was picked to train at the Army Sports Institute and the Mission Olympics Wing in Pune.

Quick Fact: Chopra was also given the Arjuna Award in 2018 and the Vishisht Seva Medal (VSM) in 2020 for his sporting achievements.

Infusion of 1500 crore rupees in IREDA was approved by the Union Cabinet.

It will support the creation of 10,200 jobs per year and the reduction of 7.49 million tonnes of carbon emissions per year.

In the last six years, the IREDA's portfolio grew from Rs 8,800 crore to Rs 28,000 crore, indicating its importance in the sector of renewable energy.

Russia-China-Iran conducts joint naval exercise CHIRU-2Q22



In the Gulf of Oman, the Russian, Chinese, and Iranian navies participated in the CHIRU-2Q22 naval exercises.

The maritime drills, which took place in the northern Indian Ocean, intended to strengthen practical collaboration between the three countries' navy.

As part of the simulation, the participants practised numerous tactics and operations, including rescuing afire vessels, saving hijacked vessels, shooting at targets, nocturnal firing at airborne targets, and other tactical manoeuvres.

Quick Fact: The military drills will involve at least 140 warships and over 60 planes, as well as roughly 10,000 military troops.

National Affairs

India has unveiled a five-year plan to become a \$300 billion electronics superpower.

For the electronics sector, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) has produced a 5-year strategy and Vision Document 2.0.

MeitY and the India Cellular and Electronics Association collaborated on the Vision Document 2.0, titled "\$300 billion in Sustainable Electronics Manufacturing and Exports by 2026." (ICEA). It is the second of two volumes in a Vision Document.

The Vision Document 2.0 includes a year-by-year breakdown as well as production forecasts for the various items. This would aid India's transformation from a US\$75 billion electronics manufacturing powerhouse to a US\$300 billion electronics manufacturing powerhouse by 2026.

Quick Fact: In November 2021, the first section of the document, titled "Increasing India's Electronics Exports and Share in GVCs," was issued.

Charanjit Singh, the former captain of the Indian hockey team, has died.

Charanjit Singh, a former hockey midfielder, died at the age of 90 after suffering a heart arrest and a series of age-related diseases.

Apple retained the title as world's valuable brand in Brand Finance 2022

According to the Brand Finance 2022 Global 500 report, Apple will continue to be the most valuable brand in 2022.

In 2022, Apple's brand value was estimated to be \$355.1 billion, a 35 percent rise over the previous year.

In the history of the Brand Finance Global 500 list, this is the highest brand value ever recorded.

Air India was officially handed over to Tata Group in the year 2022.



On January 27, 2022, the Indian government officially turned over India's flag carrier, Air India, to the Tata Group, nearly 69 years after acquiring the conglomerate.

The deal is worth **Rs 18,000 crore (US\$2.4 billion)** in total. The transfer of a 100 percent stake in Air India by the Government of India to Tata Sons, as well as management control, is part of the strategic disinvestment transaction.

Quick Fact: The deal involves three companies: Air India, Air India Express, and Air India SATS (AI SATS).

Lucknow Super Giants will be the name of the IPL team from Lucknow.

Sanjiv Goenka's (RPSG Group) IPL franchise in Lucknow has been dubbed Lucknow Super Giants ahead of the Indian Premier League (IPL) mega auction in 2022.

KL Rahul was named captain of the Lucknow team, which also included Australia all-rounder Marcus Stoinis and leg-spinner Ravi Bishnoi.

On the 3rd of January 2022, the official IPL team of Lucknow crowdsourced its name from fans and launched a consumer engagement campaign on social media.

In the Netherlands, the world's largest canal lock was unveiled.

At Ijmuiden, a small port city in the Port of Amsterdam, The Netherlands, the world's largest canal lock was inaugurated.

The Ijmuiden lock was built to help huge, contemporary cargo ships reach Amsterdam's port.

The sea lock at ljmuiden is 500 metres (1,640 ft) long and 70 metres broad. The major infrastructure project started in 2016 and was supposed to be completed in 2019. It also cost roughly €300 million (\$338 million) more than expected.

Bharti Airtel will receive a \$1 billion investment from Google.

Bharti Airtel and Google have launched a long-term cooperation to help India's digital ecosystem grow faster. Google would spend \$1 billion in Airtel as part of the agreement.

Google would invest USD 700 million of the overall investment to acquire a 1.28 percent interest in Bharti Airtel Ltd.

The remaining USD 300 million will be used to fund multi-year commercial agreements with Airtel, including products developed in collaboration between the two tech giants.

There are four printing presses in India that print and supply banknotes. These are in Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra (owned by SPMCIL), Karnataka (owned by Mysore), and West Bengal (owned by Bharatiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran Private Limited (BRBNMPL)).

With an 18.6% market share, Air India is the largest foreign carrier operating out of India. Tata Sons has taken up a Rs 10,000 crore SBI credit and a Rs 5,000 crore BoB loan. The amount of the HDFC Bank loan is unknown at this time. The loans are unrated, unsecured, and have an annual interest rate of 4.25 percent.
